DRILLING OPERATION POSITIONS

Are responsible for operating and maintaining drilling materials and equipment on the rig.

People with a two or three-year college program in a technical program (such as Mechanical or Civil Engineering) have a better chance of getting hired as part of a drilling rig crew. As with all offshore jobs, there are required safety courses that need to be completed to work in this field.

Workers gain training and qualifications through on-the-job experience and can then progress to jobs with more responsibilities, and better pay.
