OFFSHORE DRILLING FLOOR WORKERS

Are responsible for operating and maintaining drilling materials and equipment on the rig.

Formal training is not required; however, completion of a two or three year college program in a technical field is considered an asset. Standard practice is for workers to gain training and qualifications through on-the-job experience.

Workers generally move from the entry-level positions of Roustabout and Roughneck through the ranks to Assistant Derrickhand and Derrickhand, into the senior positions of Driller and Toolpusher.
